In August, the Church celebrates some truly awesome Catholics/events:

- 1. **August 1 –** St. Alphonse Liguori Started the Redemptorist order Doctor of the Church.
- August 2 St. Julian Eymard 19th century France Started the order Priests of the Blessed Sacrament.
- August 4 St. John Vianney devoted his life to the confessional – people came from all over France for his counsel.
- 4. August 6 Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord.
- August 8 Contemporary of St. Francis of Assisi rosary is attributed to him – Start the Order of Preachers (Dominicans).
- August 9 St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross Born Edith Stein to a Jewish family, she read the autobiography of St. Teresa of Avila – became a Discalced Carmelite – died at Auschwitz.

- 7. St. Lawrence 3rd century Deacon and martyr highly venerated by ancient Roman church.
- August 14 St. Maximillian Kolbe During imprisonment in Auschwitz, he offered himself in exchange for a father of a large family – this man came to St. Maximillian's canonization.
- 9. **August 15 –** Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Promulgated in 1950 by Pope Pius XII.
- August 21 Pope S. Pius X Died at outbreak of WWI – started devotion to the Eucharist.
- 11. August 24 St. Bartholomew Apostle.
- August 28 St. Augustine 4th-5th century Doctor of the Church – One of the most prolific writers – One of the four great founders of religious orders – son of St. Monica.
