Happy August to my Brother Knights and families, I hope you're all enjoying this summer and recent nice weather!

Our officers have been spending a lot of time planning out this coming fraternal year and this will be an exciting year for sure. We are influenced this year by a message from our State Deputy Christopher Kolomjec to emphasize our fraternal organization. Specifically, that "we are a fraternal organization that does charity" so let's make sure we have fun carryout our Catholic mission to serve others. With this spirit, we have added to this year's schedule many social events as well as the great number of Faith in Action events. I am excited to share these details at the end of this article and while there are some details being worked out, you will be updated regularly.

As discussed at the July General Membership meeting, we have received permission to start work on a new 3-D Ultrasound Machine for the Image of God Crisis Pregnancy Center. The good news is that our Brother Knight Don Heydens has made contact with the Livingston County Ultrasound Initiative, a fundraising organization focused on the prolife movement. Our Council has already received a \$10,000 donation from this group, thank God! What a great start for a great cause!!

I'd like to thank Brother Gary Lusk for his two years as Membership Director. Gary had the task of drawing in new members in our social based group throughout the Covid pandemic. Gary's positive spirit was a great inspiration especially during these recent times. Coming into the Membership Director(s) role are Brothers Jim Ososkie, Steve Sierawski and Dan Weingartz. We are looking forward to their involvement and bringing fresh ideas into our search for Catholic men to join our ranks and help to make sure our Go and Do! theme is successful.

If you had the opportunity to attend or volunteer at the St. Lawrence Parish picnic in July, you saw all of the hard work that Brother Jason Meyers put into this event. Thank you, Jason, for taking the lead with the picnic. Your attention to detail was obvious and the day was quite fun. Thanks also to our cooks, bartenders and those that helped set-up and clean-up. If you weren't able to come out for this, please make it a point to attend in 2023.

George also is a Fourth-Degree member with St. John Neumann Assembly 478 where he held the offices of Pilot, Navigator, Admiral and Trustee.


George retired from Chrysler after 24 years as a proto type body build coordinator.

Our Lady of the Assumption Prayer




