<u>February Feast Days</u>




The Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord 40 days after the birth of Jesus. Before 1969, the feast was known as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, or Candlemas. It was celebrated in the earliest times in the Church in Jerusalem and from there the observance spread throughout the Christian world.

According to the law of Moses, a woman was ritually unclean for 40 days after childbirth. Therefore, Mary and Joseph took Jesus

to the Temple to present him to the Lord and offer sacrifice for purification. "... just as it is written in the law of the Lord, 'Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord,' and to offer the sacrifice of 'a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons...'" (Luke 2:23-24)

Scholastica was the twin sister of St. Benedict of Nursia, founder of the Benedictine Order. It was said that she was sensorated to God at her birth, but continued to live at her

consecrated to God at her birth, but continued to live at home until her brother founded his monastery at Monte Cassino. She then, in turn, established a convent in the nearby town of Plombariola.


Our Lady of Lourdes Feast Day February 11th


Ash Wednesday February 22
