- 1. July 1 St. Junipero Serra 18th century Started many missions in California.
- 2. July 3 St. Thomas the Apostle upon seeing Jesus's wounds, he exclaimed "My Lord and my God," making a public profession of the divinity of Jesus.
- July 6 St. Maria Gioretti incredible story of forgiveness.
 Attacked at age 11. She repulsed her attackers' sexual advances. He stabbed her 11 times. She forgave him before dying. He eventually ended up a brother of the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin.
- 4. July 11 St. Benedict Father of Western Monasticism 6th century.
- 5. July 14 St. Kateri Tekakwitha First Native American to be recognized as a saint. 17th century. Raised by a Mohawk chief upon becoming Catholic she chose Kateri which is a derivative of Catherine (for Catherine of Siena).
- July 21 St. Lawrence of Brindisi (not our Parish patron St. Lawrence) – joined Capuchins and worked on converting Jews and sent to Germany to combat Lutheranism – Doctor of the Church.
- 7. July 22 St. Mary Magdalene mentioned at least a dozen

- times in scripture. She was the first to recognize Jesus after his resurrection.
- 8. July 31 St. Ignatious of Loyola 16th soldier upon his conversion he starts the Society of Jesus (Jesuits).

Update Your Beneficiaries

Sometimes it is easy to overlook the simplest of things.

Take, for example, the beneficiaries on your life insurance policies. If your policy was applied for and issued several years ago, it may very well be that the person your originally selected as the beneficiary is no longer the person you would want to receive the policy proceeds.
