September is the month of Our Lady of Sorrows.

Thanks to everyone who helped at the August breakfast, St. Lawrence Family Picnic, and MI Drive Picnic. Thanks also to Scott Morgan, Deputy Grand Knight, for conducting our August 31st meeting.

The 135th Supreme Convention in St. Louis wrapped up in August. Supreme Knight Carl Anderson announced a new initiative to rebuild a town in Iraq destroyed by ISIS. The Supreme Knight also cited the major accomplishments of the Knights of Columbus, such as the Order's record levels of charity, with over \$177 million in donations and over 75 million hours of volunteer service.

In this week's edition of the Michigan Catholic, Catholic journalist George Weigel wrote an article about the church in Detroit; he alluded to the initiative by Archbishop Vigneron, Unleashing the Gospel.

In September the Church celebrates some truly awesome Catholics:

- 1. Sep. 5 St. Teresa of Calcutta modern day started the Missionaries of Charity.
- Sep. 9 St. Peter Claver Patron saint of Negro Missions worked in 17th century Cartagena (modern day Columbia) through his efforts, three hundred thousand slaves were brought into the Church.
- Sep. 13 St. John Chrysostom (golden-mouthed, named for his eloquence). 4th century. Considered one of the greatest "lights" in Church.

- Sep. 17 St. Robert Bellarmine opposed the early Reformation heretics. Was a mentor to St. Aloysius Gonzaga and helped St. Francis De Sales establish his visitation order. He opposed severe actions against Galileo
- Sep. 18 St. Joseph Cupertino Patron saint of aviators and flying. Thought to be slow, he eventually grew to be quite holy. At least seventy times he was seen elevated while saying Mass and quite often was seen levitating while in intense prayer.
- Sep. 19 St. Januarius What is believed to be Januarius' blood is kept in Naples, as a relic. It liquifies and bubbles when exposed in the cathedral. Scientists have not been able to explain this <u>miracle</u> to date. Martyred around 305.
- 7. Sep. 20 Sts. Andrew Kim Taegon, Paul Chong Hasang, and Companions 19th century martyrs in Korea.
- 8. Sep. 29 St. Michael the Archangel the prayer we offer to him was conceived by Pope Leo XIII after hearing a conversation between the Lord and Satan.




