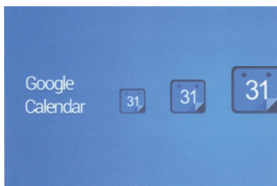

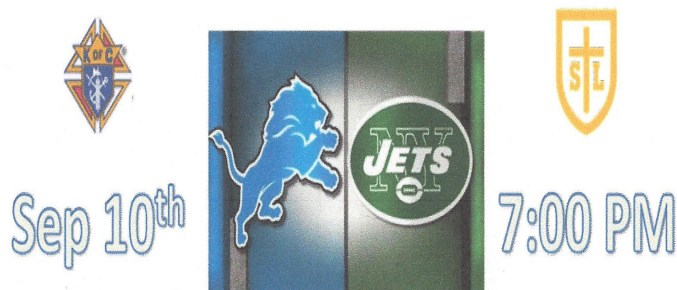

Raising Awareness about Life Insurance

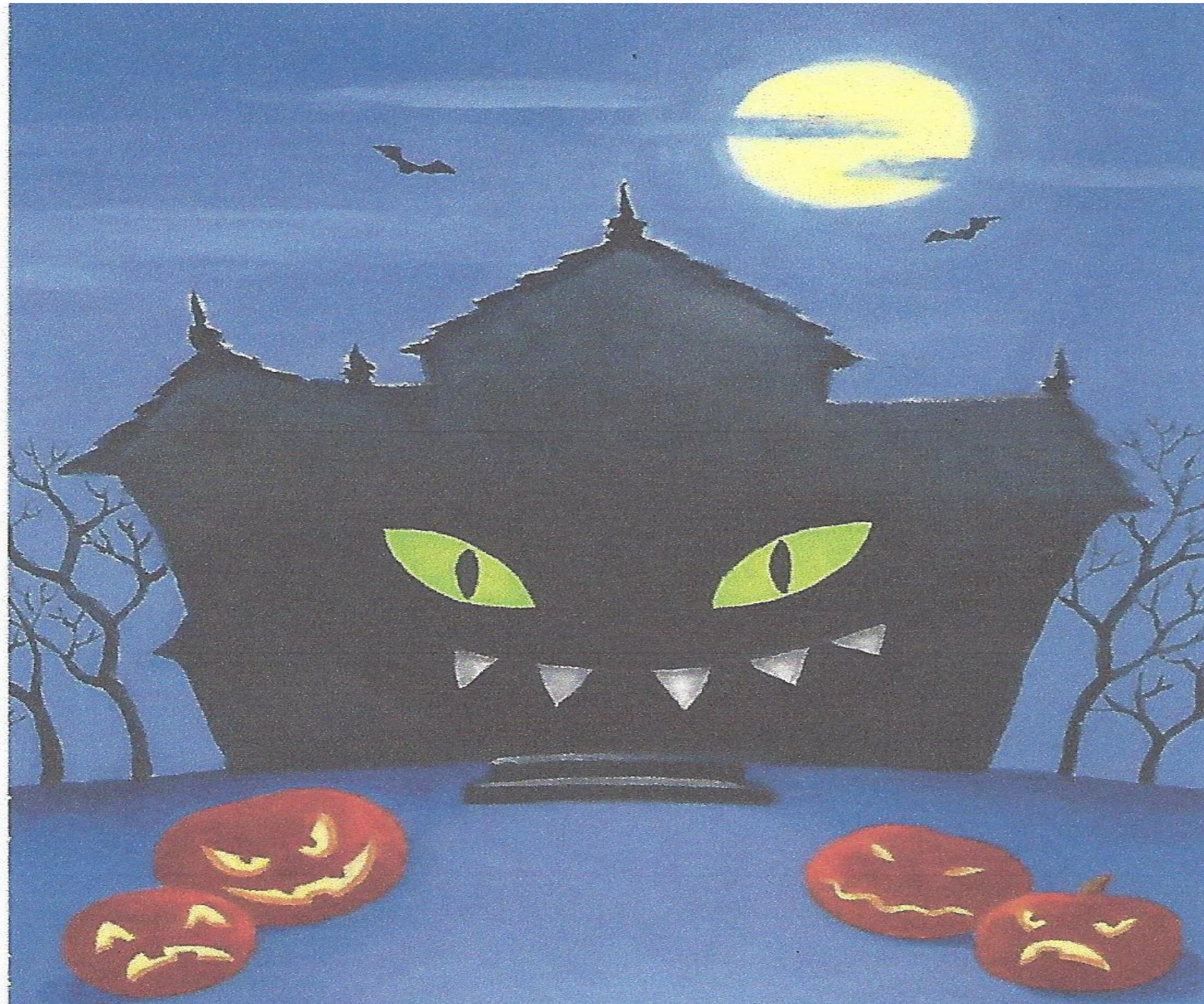

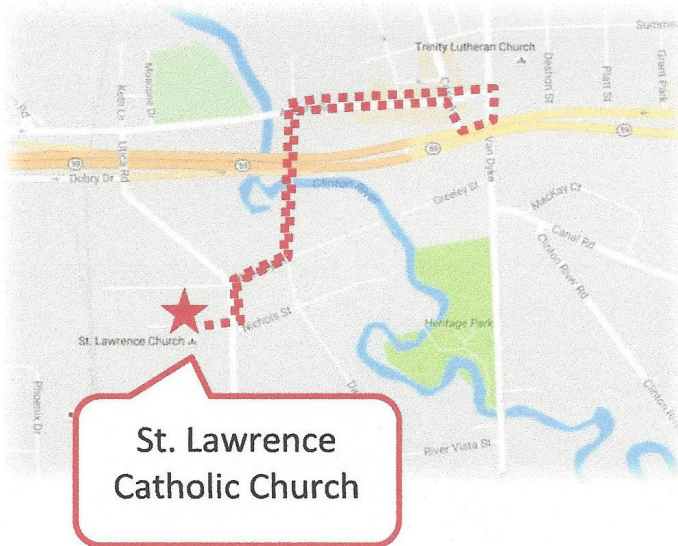

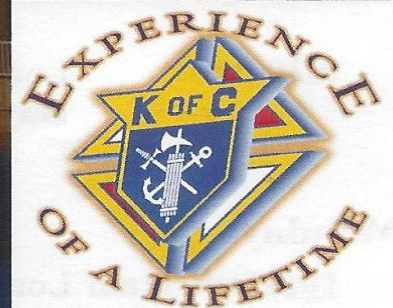
