- 4. Next you will be prompted to log in. If you are a first time user of the online scheduling, even if you are an existing donor, you will have to register as a "New User." Just follow the online steps to register they are easy!
- 5. After you register, you will go to the appointment screen. Select one of the times that is available and convenient for you. We will be there from 2:00 pm 8:00 pm.
- 6. After you select an appointment, then just confirm your time.

It's that easy!!! In fact, it is sooooo easy, YOU SHOULD REGISTER RIGHT NOW!!! If you have any questions about whether you are eligible to donate, before you sign up for an appointment you can call the Donor Suitability Hotline at 866-236-3276 to find out. Or, if you have any other questions about donating blood, visit the American Red Cross website at www.redcrosssblood.org.




