The Family of the Month for August is Dale and Karen Niedzwiecki. Dale and Karen reside in Attica for the past 2 years.



Prayer for the Canonization of Blessed Michael McGivney








Council Meeting Change!!

August 10, 2023 Annual Family Picnic and 2023 MI Drive Check Distribution


