Here are the details regarding the Blood Drive:

WHEN: June 18, 2013 from 2:00 pm to 7:45 pm *WHERE:* Knights Of Columbus Hall (Adjacent to St. Lawrence Catholic Church on Utica Road just South of M59) - 44425 Utica Road, Utica 48317

HOW YOU CAN SIGN UP: Signing up is easy and you can do it right now. Here's how:

- 1. Go to www.redcrossblood.org. Select "Search by Zip Code."
- 2. Enter 48317; 5 miles; 6/18/13; and 6/18/13 in the fields. Then select "Find."
- 3. The Blood Drive at St. Lawrence Knights of Columbus will show up. Select "Schedule an Appointment."
- 4. Next you will be prompted to log in. If you are a first time user of the online scheduling, even if you are an existing donor, you will have to register as a "New User." Just follow the online steps to register they are easy.
- 5. After you register you will go to the appointment screen. Select one of the times that is available and convenient for you. We will be there from 2:00 pm 8:00 pm.

It's that easy!!! In fact, it is sooooo easy. *YOU SHOULD REGISTER RIGHT NOW!!!* If you have any questions about whether you are eligible to donate, before you sign up for an appointment you can call the Donor Suitability Hotline at 866-236-3276 to find out. Or, if you have any other questions about donating blood, visit the American Red Cross website at www.redcrossblood.org.

We really need your help. If you are having any doubts about donating ask yourself, "Would I donate if it saved my friend's life? My brother's life? My child's life?" You know you would! And that is exactly what you *WILL BE* doing. Each pint of blood donated helps 3 people - someone's friend, someone's sibling, and someone's child. 
